Abstract:	A detailed inventory of the relevant National and European regulations affecting the ALEHOOP Project has been prepared to assess the Legal and Ethics requirements. It summarises the legislations that pertain to the allocated work packages along with the relevant partners who are involved in the project. The legislations have been divided into eight large groups depending on their general area of concern. The pertinent partners associated with the work packages admissible to a particular regulation have then been mentioned. Each legislation is accompanied by a summary of the content of the particular legislation along with a link to the legislation.	

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1. Summary of the legislations with the work packages and relevant partners of alehhop

1.1 General Food Safety and Feed Hygiene Regulations:

REGULATION (EC) No 178/2002 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 28 January2002, laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety

Summary: This Regulation provides the basis for the assurance of a high level of protection of human health and consumers' interest in relation to food, taking into account in particular the diversity in the supply of food including traditional products, whilst ensuring the effective functioning of the internal market. It establishes common principles and responsibilities, the means to provide a strong science base, efficient organisational arrangements and procedures to underpin decision-making in matters of food and feed safety. It lays down the general principles governing food and feed in general, and food and feed safety in particular, at Community and national level and establishes the European Food Safety Authority. It lays down procedures for matters with a direct or indirect impact on food and feed safety.

REGULATION (EC) No 183/2005 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 12 January 2005, laying down requirements for feed hygiene

Summary: This Regulation establishes rules for high level of consumer protection with regard to food and feed safety. It lays down general rules on feed hygiene, conditions and arrangements ensuring traceability of feed and conditions and arrangements for registration and approval of establishments. It shall apply to the activities of feed business operators at all stages, from and including primary production of feed, up to and including, the placing of feed on the market; the feeding of food-producing animals; and the imports and exports of feed from and to third countries.

REGULATION (EC) No 852/2004 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 29 April 2004, on the hygiene of foodstuffs

Summary: This Regulation lays down general rules for food business operators on the hygiene of foodstuffs, taking particular account of the principles of primary responsibility for food safety rests with the food business operator; it's necessity to ensure food safety throughout the food chain, starting with primary production; it's importance, for food that cannot be stored safely at ambient temperatures, particularly frozen food, to maintain the cold chain; the general implementation of procedures based on the HACCP principles, together with the application of good hygiene practice, should reinforce food business operators' responsibility; guides to good practice are a valuable instrument to aid food business operators at all levels of the food chain with compliance with food hygiene rules and with the application of the HACCP principles; it's necessity to establish microbiological criteria and temperature control requirements based on a scientific risk assessment; it's necessity to ensure that imported foods are of at least the same hygiene standard as food produced in the Community, or are of an equivalent standard. This Regulation shall apply to all stages of production, processing and distribution of food and to exports, and without prejudice to more specific requirements relating to food hygiene.

DIRECTIVE 2009/32/EC OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 23 April 2009, on the approximation of the laws of the Member States on extraction solvents used in the production of foodstuffs and food ingredients

Summary: This Directive applies to extraction solvents used or intended for use in the production of foodstuffs or food ingredients. It shall not apply to extraction solvents used in the production of food additives, vitamins and other nutritional additives, unless such food additives, vitamins or nutritional additives that are listed. However, it shall be ensured that the use of food additives, vitamins and other nutritional additives does not result in foodstuffs containing extraction solvent residue levels dangerous to human health.

1.2 Regulations to Ensure the Protection of Animals, Environment and the Human Health:

REGULATION (EC) No 1935/2004 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 October 2004, on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food and repealing Directives 80/590/EEC and 89/109/EEC

Summary: The purpose of this Regulation is to ensure the effective functioning of the internal market in relation to the placing on the market in the Community of materials and articles intended to come into contact directly or indirectly with food, whilst providing the basis for securing a high level of protection of human health and the interests of consumers.

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This Regulation shall apply to materials and articles, including active and intelligent food contact materials and articles, which in their finished state are intended to be brought into contact with food; or are already in contact with food and were intended for that purpose; or can reasonably be expected to be brought into contact with food or to transfer their constituents to food under normal or foreseeable conditions of use.

COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 2023/2006 of 22 December 2006, on good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food

Summary: This Regulation lays down the rules on good manufacturing practice (GMP) for the groups of materials and articles intended to come into contact with food and combinations of those materials and articles or recycled materials and articles used in those materials and articles. It shall apply to all sectors and to all stages of manufacture, processing and distribution of materials and articles, up to but excluding the production of starting substances.

Summary: This Directive lays down measures to protect the environment and human health by preventing or reducing the adverse impacts of the generation and management of waste and by reducing overall impacts of resource use and improving the efficiency of such use. It ensures that the waste policy should be able to minimise the negative effects of the generation and management of waste on human health and the environment. It should also aim at reducing the use of resources, and favour the practical application of the waste hierarchy.

Summary: This Directive establishes measures for the protection of animals used for scientific or educational purposes. This Directive establishes measures for the protection of animals used for scientific or educational purposes. It lays down rules on the replacement and reduction of the use of animals in procedures and the refinement of the breeding, accommodation, care and use of animals in procedures; the origin, breeding, marking, care and accommodation and killing of animals; the operations of breeders, suppliers and users; the evaluation and authorisation of projects involving the use of animals

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in procedures. This Directive shall apply where animals are used or intended to be used in procedures, or bred specifically so that their organs or tissues may be used for scientific purposes.

3.3.1 REGULATION (EC) No 1925/2006 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 20 December 2006, on the addition of Vitamins and Minerals and of certain other substances to foods

Summary: This Regulation aims to regulate the addition of vitamins and minerals to foods and the use of certain other substances or ingredients containing substances other than vitamins or minerals that are added to foods or used in the manufacture of foods under conditions that result in the ingestion of amounts greatly exceeding those reasonably expected to be ingested under normal conditions of consumption of a balanced and varied diet and/ or would otherwise represent a potential risk to consumers.

1.4 Regulations Concerning the Maximum Level of Contaminants in Food and Feedstuff:

3.4.1 COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 1881/2006 of 19 December 2006, setting maximum levels for certain contaminants in foodstuffs

Summary: This Regulation lays down maximum levels to be applied to dried, diluted, processed and compound foodstuff to ensure an efficient protection of public health. It establishes the maximum levels at a strict level which is reasonably achievable by following good agricultural, fishery and manufacturing practices and taking into account the risk related to the consumption of the food. In order to protect public health, this Regulation ensures to keep the contaminants at levels which are toxicologically acceptable.

Summary: This Regulation establishes, in accordance with the general principles laid down in Regulation (EC) No 178/2002, in particular the need to ensure a high level of consumer protection and harmonised Community provisions relating to maximum levels of pesticide residues in or on food and feed of plant and animal origin. It shall apply to products of plant and animal origin to be used as fresh, processed and/or composite food or feed in or on which pesticide residues may be present.

3.4.7 DIRECTIVE 2002/32/EC OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 7 May 2002, on undesirable substances in animal feed

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Summary: This Directive lays down rules on feeding stuffs are needed to ensure agricultural productivity and sustainability and to make it possible to ensure public and animal health, animal welfare and the environment. It ensures that the maximum levels of undesirable substances that are set apply in general from the date on which the products intended for animal feed are put into circulation or used, at all stages, and in particular as soon as they are imported. This directive states the importance of the contents in products intended for animal feed be reduced, with due regard to the substances' acute toxicity, bioaccumulability and degradability, in order to prevent undesirable and harmful effects.

1.5 Regulations Concerning Foodstuffs for Particular Nutritional Uses:

DIRECTIVE 2009/39/EC OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 6 May 2009, on foodstuffs intended for particular nutritional uses

Summary: This Directive concerns the foodstuffs whose composition and preparation must be specially designed to meet the particular nutritional requirements of the persons for whom they are mainly intended. The particular nutritional use shall fulfil the particular nutritional requirements of certain categories of persons whose digestive processes or metabolism are disturbed; or of certain categories of persons who are in a special physiological condition and who are therefore able to obtain special benefit from controlled consumption of certain substances in foodstuffs; or of infants or young children in good health.

This Regulation applies to the processing of personal data wholly or partly by automated means and to the processing other than by automated means of personal data which form part of a filing system or are intended to form part of a filing system.

Summary: In accordance with this Regulation, the institutions and bodies set up by, or on the basis of, the Treaties establishing the European Communities, shall protect the fundamental rights and freedoms of natural persons, and in particular their right to privacy with respect to the processing of personal data and shall neither restrict nor prohibit the free flow of personal data between themselves or to recipients subject to the national law of the Member States implementing Directive 95/46/EC. It ensures that the independent supervisory authority established by this Regulation, shall monitor the application of the provisions of this Regulation to all processing operations carried out by a Community institution or body.

COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) No 1268/2012 of 29 October 2012, on the rules of application of Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union

Summary: This Regulation lays down the rules of application for Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012. This Regulation provides and ensures for exceptions which reflect the specific operational features of that sector, mainly as regards procurement and the award of grants, notably because these procedures are carried out by the authorities of third countries receiving Union financial support; as regards procurement, such differences should mainly pertain to types of procedures and thresholds from which they apply; and as regards grants, full financing should be allowed in certain cases, mainly to take the reduced co-financing capacity of the beneficiaries into account.
